#### So...... What's in a Name?



Robert the Bruce was the first King of Independent Scotland from 1306 to 1329. No connection, but there's also a 21<sup>st</sup> century Robert the Bruce and this one is a beautiful little Shetland Sheepdog who belongs to Joann Weschler. She, her husband Lou and "Robby" moved into Friendship Village in Tempe in the summer of 2011 when he was three. Ever since, Joann and Robbie have been a CAAA team visiting the Health Care Center there.

The Healthcare Center offers various levels of care. Joann and Robby visit the Alzheimer area where

they meet patients in the community living room. Robby goes from person to person while Joann encourages interaction by having him perform tricks for everyone. With every trick he gets a small treat. If the patients are able, she allows them to offer Robby his treats; but only after making sure they know it's for him and not them!

When it comes to teaching dogs tricks as well as obedience Joann has had years of experience. In the mid 80's she had heard from a friend in Davis California about a new concept in dog training; basic obedience classes for puppies. After some research she and her partner became the first in Arizona to offer "Puppy Classes". Their eight week classes were limited to 12 puppies, 8 to 12 weeks in age. They required vet verification of health and only adult or older teen handlers. The training was aimed at getting the puppies socialized



early along with some basic obedience and a few tricks. Joann says it's extremely important to get your puppy socialized EARLY; before ten weeks old. Get them used to other places, people and always other dogs. One of the most effective techniques used to socialize her

"students" were to have everyone sit in a circle on the grass with their puppy in their lap. After a short period of time they were told to pass their puppy to the left. The passing continued until each puppy completed the circle and ended where they started, with their owners.

Of course there was plenty of running and playing as well and the puppies loved it! And so did their owners. After a year or two they wanted another class for older puppies. So Joann added one with continued training in obedience and even a small agility course for puppies. For older dogs she also taught classes at the Phoenix Field and Obedience Club that were aimed at competition with the American Kennel Club.

When requested, Joann and Robby visit other areas of the Friendship Village Healthcare Center; especially when any of her neighbors are temporarily in the hospital wing. Joann recalls a time when visiting a good friend after falling and breaking her leg in several places. She was in shorts and her bare feet were sticking out at the end of her hospital bed. Robby looked at them and then start licking her left foot. Robby was told to stop but the friend wasn't minding the massage at all, so he didn't. "The funny thing" Joann says "is that he looked at the right foot but had no interest in it; only the left one. And that was the leg that had been injured".

To date, Joann
and Robby have
well over 200
visits as they
continue to visit at
Friendship Village
every Monday.




